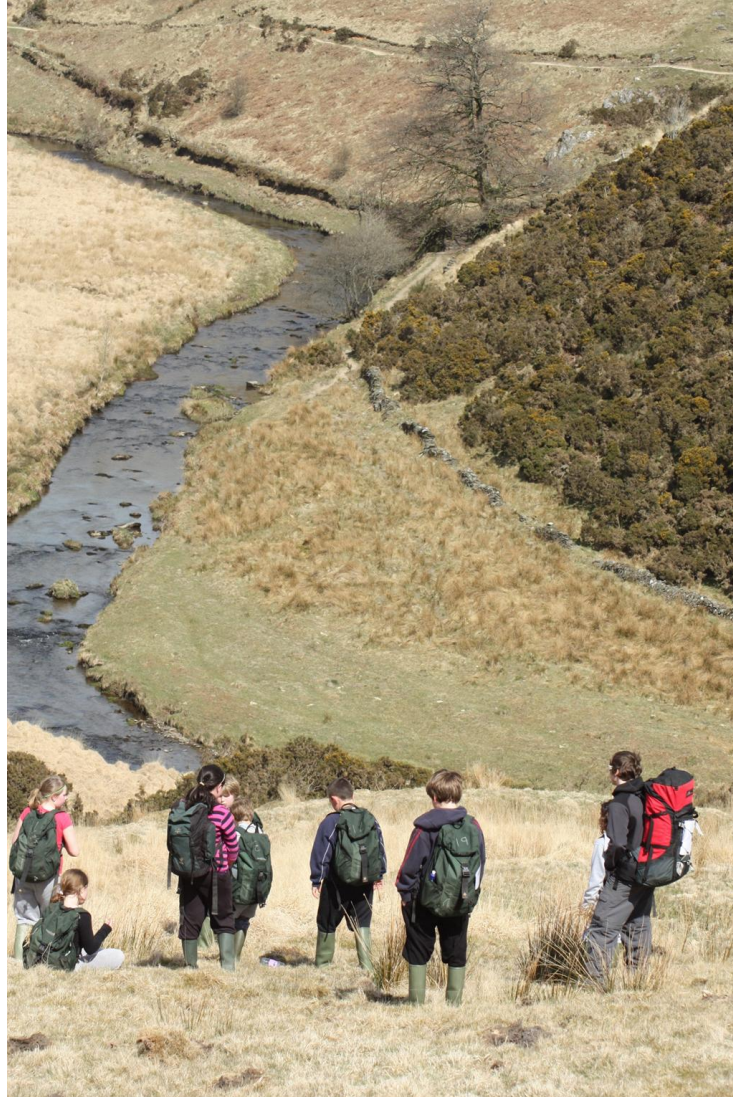

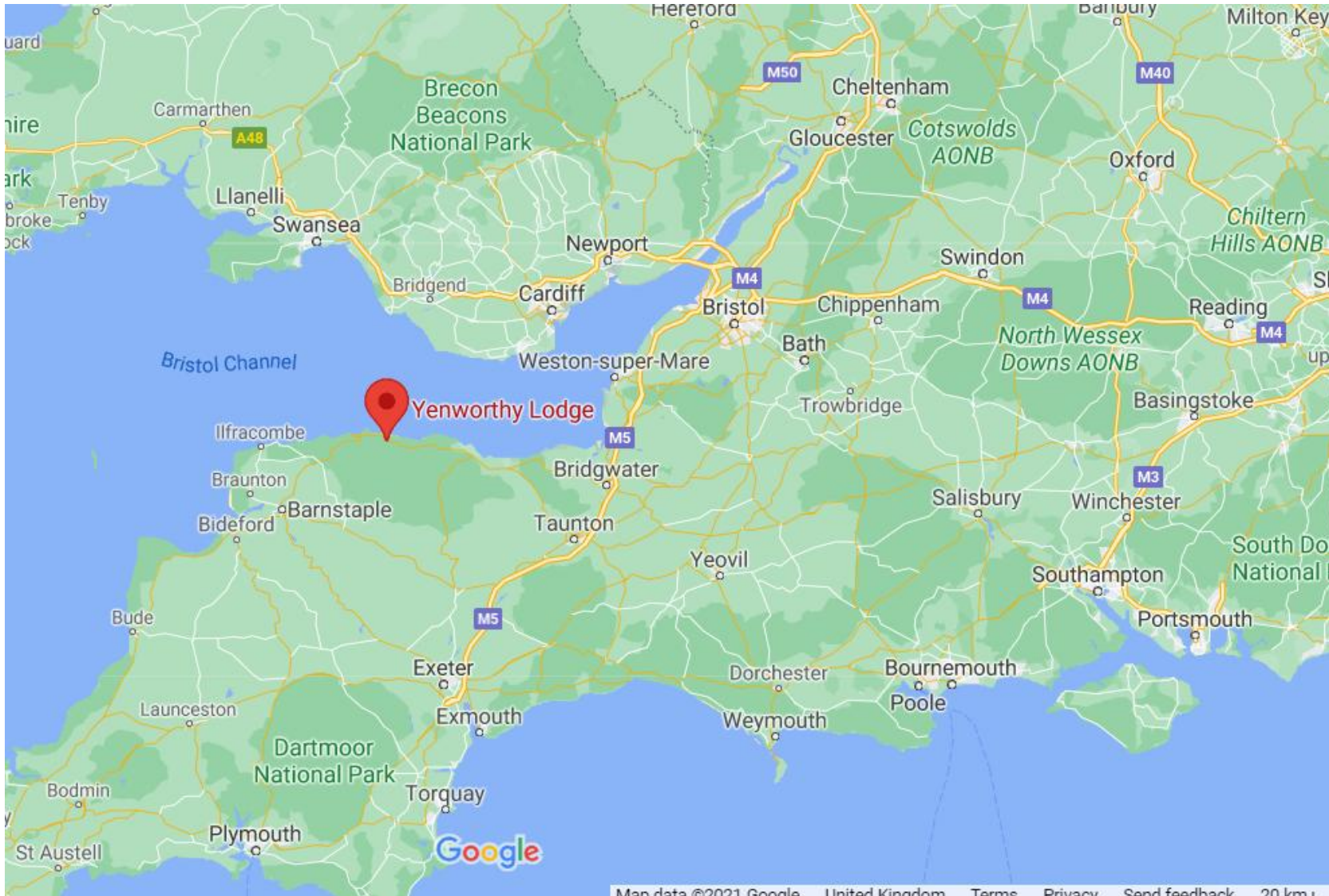

A day in the life of Yenworthy

Groups

- ▶ Before we go, children will have the opportunity to tell us a number of children that they would like to be in a group with.
- ▶ We will then endeavour to ensure that all children are with at least one other child from their list.
- ▶ We decide groups with the intention of giving each child a fun, safe and memorable experience.

What you will need

- ▶ You will have been sent a copy of the kit list of what your child needs to bring
- ▶ Things of note:
 - ▶ Your child will need their own duvet cover, pillow-case and fitted sheet
 - ▶ Children are not allowed to bring their phone on the trip (it is recommended that no valuables are brought)
 - ▶ Waterproof jackets and over trousers, wellington boots, walking boots and day rucksacks are provided by the centre for the duration of the course and at no charge
 - ▶ Aerosol deodorants are not allowed as they can trigger the fire alarm system and trigger asthmatic symptoms
 - ▶ **Please ensure that all items are named!**
 - ▶ Teachers will collect **any medication** on the Monday morning before the coach leaves and will look after it for the duration of the trip (please ensure this is clearly labelled, with instructions in a bag/container)

Worries and concerns

- ▶ What do I do if my child is feeling anxious?
 - ▶ This is going to be a fantastic trip that will challenge the children in the best way possible. Please normalise feeling nervous, whilst also reassuring your child that they are going to have a lovely time and their teachers will be there to support them.
- ▶ My child doesn't want to go
 - ▶ Mostly as above! This is such an amazing experience for the children and we really want as many of them as possible to join us.
- ▶ My child gets homesick- what will happen when they're away?
 - ▶ We will comfort the children as a parent would at home- your child will have a hug if they need one! We understand this is a big event for many children and we will be sensitive to this in how we treat them. If there is anything that urgently needs to be communicated to parents, then the adults will have phones and we will contact you.
- ▶ What happens if my child feels unwell?
 - ▶ As above, we will comfort the children if they feel unwell. We will have basic medical supplies should they need them and will gain your consent before using these.
